THE AIRSTREAM OWNER

Follow these rules for top performance and maximum life from your Goodyear Mobile Home Tires, which support your fine new Airstream Trailer: -

1. It is important to check air pressure in your tires before starting on a trip and when the tires are cool. Be sure to have correct pressure before driving (see chart), also make sure valve cores and valve caps are tight.
2. When parked between trips, maintain recommended air pressure in all tires.
3. Hold speeds to a maximum of 50 mph. Obey state towing laws!
4. Whenever possible, park in a shaded area so that tires are not exposed to the direct rays of the sun.
5. If parking for extended periods of time, put your trailer on blocks, so tires do not touch the ground; better still if local parking regulations permit, and if facilities are available, remove tires and store them in a dry, cool enclosure.
6. Wherever you park or travel, chances are there is a Goodyear Dealer or Store nearby. See him for tire service!
