Welcome to the 6th annual Dead Horse Rally. Below is the tentative schedule of events for the weekend. Times and events are subject to change, so check the bulletin board located in the Ramada area for and updates.

Friday – 2/17

- Noon until ??? – Arrival time - Find a spot and set up camp. If you need to dump your tanks there is a dump station located just inside the park after you pass the ranger station.
- 4:30pm – Happy Hour Plus – Bring your beverage of choice or enjoy a drink (or two) from the world famous M-Ball. Bring a snack to share as well. There is no dinner planned, so make your snacks accordingly.
- Dark – Time to light the fire and enjoy some great stories

Saturday – 2/18

- 8:00am until 9:30am – Boil Bag Breakfast – Build your own omelet. We will supply all of the ingredients.
- Mid day – Enjoy the sights and activities of the Verde Valley. Fishing for Trout in the Park Lagoons (AZ License required), hiking or biking the Park Trails, Antique shopping in Old Town Cottonwood or whatever; It's your time to do what you want.
- 4:00pm – Saturday Night Fever Begins – Cocktail Hour starts at 4:00 so get dressed in your disco outfit and visit the M-Ball and listen to some great disco music. This is followed at 5:00 with our pot luck dinner. Bring what you want and enjoy. During the cocktail hour and dinner you can vote for your favorite Disco Guy, Gal and Couple. Prizes for the best will be awarded at the end of dinner. Shortly after the dinner the white elephant gift exchange begins and after that it's time for another night at the campfire.

Sunday – 2/19

- Noon – Travel Safe!

Things we are providing:

- Friday and Saturday nights camping fees
- Coffee every morning (around 7:00am)
- M-Ball Friday and Saturday evening
- Breakfast Omelet on Saturday Morning
- Disco contest prizes
- Pastries on Monday morning

Things you need to bring:

- Plates and silverware for every meal
- Appetizer for Friday Night
- Food item for Saturday Pot Luck (main dish or side dish or salad or dessert)
- Food item for Sunday breakfast
- Disco outfit for Saturday Night Fever
- Wrapped gift for elephant exchange (1 per person max)
- Firewood for the campfire
- Chairs for around the campfire
- Warm cloths (it gets cool at night)
- Disco music (CD or cassette)

When you arrive at the ranger station, tell them that you are with the Airstream Group. They should then give you a 2 day pass for entering the park. If you arrive after the ranger station closes for the night, you will need to pick up your pass the next morning. Proceed from there to the Group Area (Raven Loop). There should be a 4CU sign at the entrance. If you arrive a day early, you will need to pay (\$15) for that at the ranger station when you arrive.

The group site is a dry camping area.

- There are a couple of water spouts in the area for hauling water to your trailer.
- There are bathrooms with showers located in the group area as well as a sink for washing dishes.
- There is a dump station located near the ranger station.
- Generators are fine for charging batteries, but should be camping generators and only used during the day time.

Pets should be on a leash and owners need to pick up after them. There is a city dog park outside of the park on the road to the park entrance.
