




2016 Sprinter Front Speaker Upgrade

<p>Instruction provided by Crutchfield on how to remove the interior cab door trim is well written and recommended for this project.</p>	
<p>OEM speaker information:</p> <p>Front Speakers Size: 4" Speakers</p> <p>Left Front Speaker Wire (+): Brown/Violet Left Front Speaker Wire (-): Brown/Green Right Front Speaker Wire (+): Brown/Orange Right Front Speaker Wire (-): Brown/Blue</p>	
<p>I discovered the interior door had sound deadening material on the interior except for the very bottom and near the door handle. So added Dynamat to those areas.</p>	
<p>Installed 2007-16 Sprinter NCV3 cab door speaker adapters for 6.5in speakers from Impact Products' eBay store. Website is www.impact3d.com/sprinter_products.htm</p>	

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I cut the connector from the removed OEM speaker frame and cleaned from it the solder and wiring. Then soldered the wiring for the new speakers to where the OEM speaker cone wires originally attached. This allowed me to avoid cutting the OEM wiring harness and make the new speaker install a plug-n-play exercise. I placed heat shrink over the connection for strength and protection.



New Kenwood KFC-1695PS 6.5" speaker installed with fabricated speaker lead running from behind the speaker, through the door and back out to connect to OEM harness plug.



I placed automotive weather stripping around the speaker to seal the gap between the speaker and interior door panel.



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
