



Cloud Cover Forecast (Percent) - 8/21, Noon

Discussion:

A mostly dry weekend ahead will likely persist into early next week, setting the stage for what appears to be a dry period around the eclipse. There is a chance for afternoon shower/thunderstorms over the Winds, Absarokas, and Laramie Ranges, but they look to hold off until later in the afternoon. At this point, generally speaking skies are expected to be partly to mostly at time of the eclipse. (Disclaimer: Predictability remains low this far out)

Hazards/Impacts:

Dry and breezy conditions (humidities of 15-20%; wind gusts 15-20 mph) may produce elevated fire conditions. Isolated t-storms in mountains.
