

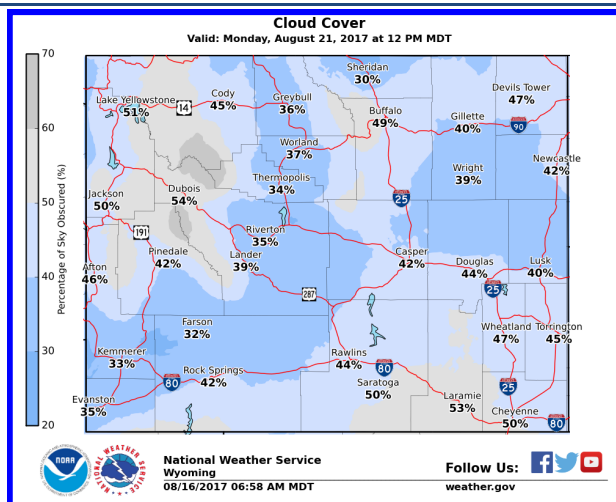

Discussion:

A mostly dry weekend, will likely persist into early next week, setting the stage for a dry period around the eclipse. There is a chance for afternoon showers/storms Monday over the Winds, Absarokas, and Laramie Ranges. Current sky cover projections suggests partly cloudy skies (30-60% cloud cover) across state. (Disclaimer: Predictability remains low this far out)

Hazards/Impacts:

Dry and breezy conditions (humidities of 15-20%; wind gusts 15-20 mph) may produce elevated fire conditions (especially areas of state haven't benefited from recent rain...west & central). Isolated storms in mountains.
