

The Flying Cloud is our main line offering...a clean, modest and mild palette - an interior that welcomes most. The International and Globetrotter models are designer series that takes cues from the Flying Cloud, but adds new elements, and in some cases upgrades. Allow me to address that later point.

International Signature Upgrades:

- Christopher Deam (and his design team) partner up with Airstream, hence the 'signature' branding
- Exterior shell is reinforced for an optional power awning (not a visual difference, but an internal one)
- Overhead lockers different shaped, slightly deeper with a switchable back light and sliding plexiglass
- Galley top is upgraded to a DuPont Corian solid surface
- Sink faucet is upgrade to a Grohe from a Moen.
- LED interior lighting is upgraded to a custom stainless steel housing
- LED exterior lighting is upgraded to a over-the-door light
- Ultra leather seating material is smooth rather than embossed (not an upgrade, but different texture for a different look)
- Lastly, some of the laminates are custom made for us by the designers

International Serenity Upgrades:

There are only slight changes between the Signature and Serenity. The Signature is to embody sleek, sophistication while being more modern. The Serenity is to embark on a more serene, spa like atmosphere that is lighter. The upgrades over a Signature come only from the fact that multiple designer teams were apart of this edition and there were more custom laminates and lighting (lamp shades). Otherwise it is similar to what is stated above under Signature.

Globetrotter Upgrades (from International):

- Brand new designer model with the winning designer hailing from London.
- All cabinetry and seating is curved, to emphasize and pay compliments to the iconic exterior curves and cues.
- Cabinetry is flush mounted (does not stand proud of the surface)
- Polk audio upgrade
- Tuft and Needle mattress
- Low profile night stands with a curved 'headboard design' above the bed to carry the seating design throughout the interior
- Fabric curtains replace foldout privacy divider, providing a softer approach
- Table is on compressible table leg for greater convenience
- Upgraded 3-way fridge
- Upgraded Franke faucet
- Upgraded power stabilizer jacks
- Woven vinyl flooring - same stain resistances, however it is more robust and longer lasting (very difficult to puncture)

- Fingerprint proof white laminate (wipes off very easy)
- Upgraded stainless steel and glass cooktop
- New storage containers behind the sink (one of the designers was a chef, and designed one for trash, and the other for compost - more euro - but it can be used as such or used for placing ice and a bottle of wine, or dog lease, etc)
- New larger under sink drawers (again from the chef point of view)
- New larger rectangle Moen stainless steel under-mount sink
- New large overhead cabinets with a automatic light (magnet controlled) and mirror (to see anything that might be hiding up there)
- New accent lighting
- New designer light switches
- Custom awning design
- Bedding includes throw(s)
- 4 different color based on two main design pallets
